John Constable was born in East Bergholt and so it is appropriate that we begin our guided tour here and take the opportunity to see the very unusual way the bells are rung at the village church. We will then proceed to Flatford Mill to discover the views that John Constable painted. Here our Blue Badge Guide will take us on a short, optional guided walk to see the scenes of four of John Constable's paintings including the site of the famous Haywain. Dedham's beautiful main street is lined with Georgian fronted houses alongside old inns, tea rooms, a large arts/crafts centre and an impressive 15th century church. An optional short guided tour will be offered at Dedham. Then we head to Beth Chatto Gardens.

Bressingham Steam Museum & Gardens



Bressingham has been the official home to the Dads Army Appreciation Society's collection since 2000. The exhibition comprises a recreation of Walmington-on-Sea the fictional home to Captain Mainwaring and his men.
